Mathematics Department

1. The 7th Bethel Cup Yuen Long District Primary School Mathematics Multi-Challenge was organised on 18/10/2014. 26 primary schools in the territory formed 94 teams to join the competition. There were 376 participants. After the competition, there was a prize presentation ceremony. Apart from team awards, there were also individual awards for outstanding participants.
2. The Mathematics Department is going to hold various Mathematics activities in school, such as speed calculation competitions, Mathematics article reading, etc., to provide more channels for students to get in touch with Mathematics, learn about Mathematics and find interest in Mathematics.

2. The S.4 growth day camp in the Community Sports in Sheung Shui was held on 24/10/2014. Students were divided into groups to complete different tasks so as to encourage their team to have spirit, self-confidence and self-discipline.

Career Guidance Team

1. 6 of our students have participated in the after-school tutorial classes provided by the Yuen Long Town Hall Support Service Centre for Ethnic Minorities. These tutorials are aimed to improve the Mathematics and Chinese academic performance of the participants as well as to help them finish their homework. The tutorials are held every Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday, from 6:30-8:00 p.m., targeting junior form non-Chinese students. The tutorials are free of charge. 2. We have prepared a 15-hour manicurist training course in the co-curricular activity period to help students discover the career that they are interested in. Through various activities in the course, students can learn basic manicure techniques and customer service. They can also learn about the training pathways, career perspectives, etc. of the manicure industry.
3. We have invited the Hong Kong Employment Development Service and the Hong Kong Christian Service to provide life planning workshops for local and non-Chinese students respectively so as to help them set up targets for development and learn about the relationship between their life experience and life planning. Through 4 sessions of workshop, we helped students to find out about their personality, interest and values so that they can carry out their life planning.
4. On 25/9/2014, we held a JUPAS talk for 6B, 6C and 6D students to introduce the JUPAS system and information such as the entrance requirements of the eight universities and other higher education institutes so that they are more confident about and have a greater chance of entering universities. 5. On 25/9/2014 and 23/10/2014, we prepared a class teacher period 'My JUPAS Guide' for 6A students to introduce the JUPAS system, programme selection procedures and strategy, etc.
6. On 27/9/2014, we held a S.1 and S.4 parent talk, 'How to help my child to do life planning'. In the talk, we used WHY, WHAT and HOW as the topics to discuss why we should have, what is and how we should do life planning for our child.
7. On 9/10/2014, we prepared a class teacher period, 'Smart Choice for HKDSE Subjects', for 3B students to introduce the related information about NSS elective subjects and the relationship between their elective subjects and future career.
8. On 11/10/2014, 9 S.6 students participated in the Open Day of the Hong Kong Polytechnic University to learn about the entrance requirements, school facilities, programme structure, career perspectives, etc. so as to prepare well for future studies.
9. On 23/10/2014, we held a talk on 'Health Care Training' to help students learn about the health care and hospital service sector as well as to know about the job nature, entry requirements, salaries, employment statistics, professional development and related courses of Health Workers and Care-related Support Workers.

Co-curricular and Extra-curricular Activities Team

1. The Co-curricular & Extra-curricular Activity Team has invited the Dodgeball Association of Hong Kong to hold a workshop to introduce the rules and techniques of dodgeball. The workshop also allowed students to try out the sport.
2. The Co-curricular & Extra-curricular Activity Team has organised a drama workshop and invited senior actors from the Chung Ying Theatre to introduce the theatre and the art of drama. The workshop also allowed students to try out drama performances.
3. The House Captain Elections have been held successfully. Yip Ching Yung of 5C was elected as the house captain of Kindly Light House. Lam Hei Lui of 5C was elected as the house captain of Glorious Light House.
