Dear Parents,

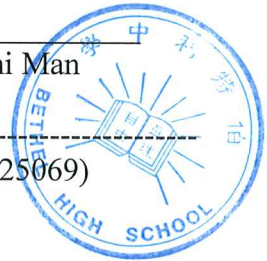

7. Dress Code

(1) Uniform regulations

- Students must wear the complete school sports uniform, which includes the school sports short-sleeve T-shirt (according to their house) and school sports long pants.
- Winter or summer school uniform is not allowed in the competition area.
- There is no exception for the House Committee members.
- In cold weather, students may wear hoodies, winter sports jackets, plain dark blue cardigans or V-neck sweaters, or school jackets that comply with school regulations.
- If student's uniform fails to follow the rules, the school reserves the right to treat it as a violation. For any questions, please call the Discipline Team at 24712622.
- During the competition, students can wear school blue sport trousers on the lower body. Non-approved clothing is not allowed in the venue and will result in disqualification from the competition.
- Students may wear class T-shirts to cheer for their classmates during the inter-class relay race but must wear the designated school attire at other times.
- If a class plans to wear class T-shirts (tops only, bottoms must follow event instructions), they must apply to the Discipline Team before the sports day, with approval from the class teacher, and submit details such as the design or photos of the T-shirts for identification purposes by the teachers and prefects responsible for maintaining discipline.

(2) Uniform inspection

Prefects and discipline teachers will be stationed at the entrance of the sports ground and to check students' uniforms and appearance. During assembly, class teachers will take attendance and inspect uniforms. During the report time and opening ceremony, class teachers must maintain student order.

(3) Treatment to those who violate school uniform rules

- Their name will be marked.
- If students wear incomplete sport uniform, their name will be marked.
- Students wearing non-approved attire or with serious uniform violations (e.g., dyed hair or more than three violations) will be isolated and **disqualified from the competition**.
- Offenders must carry a "Uniform and Appearance Violation Notice" filled out by a discipline teacher or prefect.

8. Rules in the sports ground

- (1) Students are not allowed to eat or drink in the spectator stand, except for water.
- (2) Students must follow the school's regulations on items allowed in the sports ground.
- (3) Students must stay within their designated house areas and watch the events.
- (4) Students are not allowed to stay in the pathway of the spectator stand.
- (5) Students must maintain order and follow teachers' instructions.
- (6) Students must keep the place clean.
- (7) Students should not read any books on the spectator stand, except the Sports Day booklet.
- (8) Students who violate the rules will face penalties or be sent to the isolation area for supervision, depending on the severity.
- (9) Students are not allowed to use mobile phones without teacher permission.

9. Procedures for going to toilet and tuck shop

- (1) Each house has 4 passes kept by the chief house teachers.
- (2) Each pass has a time limit of 10 minutes.
- (3) The aisles between the spectator stands are reserved for queuing.
- (4) Students must queue and hand over their student ID or handbook (which they must carry) to the prefect for time registration. If a student does not have their ID or handbook, they must seek assistance from the house teacher or be supervised by a prefect to go to the restroom. Students should have a valid pass to go to the toilet.
- (5) Offenders / late comers will be sent to the isolated area.

10. Students in the isolated area cannot join any competitions and will be supervised by teachers of the Order Team. If they violate rules in the isolated area, they will be punished to copy the school rules or compositions.
