



《First Term Examination and S.6 Final Examination》

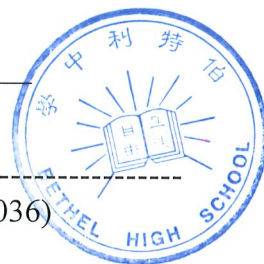
Dear S.6 Parents,

The details of the First Term Examination and S.6 Final Examination are listed below. It is hoped that parents can encourage their child to better prepare for the examination:

1. The First Term Examination for S.1 – S.5 will be held from 3/1/2020 to 14/1/2020. S.6 students will have lessons as usual.
2. The S.6 Final Examination will be held from 15/1/2020 to 5/2/2020. During the examination period, students should come to school and go to the examination venue by 8:10 a.m. Students have to arrive at the examination venue at least 15 minutes before each examination session.
3. Casual leave for students during the examination period will not be allowed except for special cases. During the examination period, no matter how short the sick leave is, students have to fill in the Application for Leave column in the Student Handbook and submit a medical certificate. If a student is absent from an examination without following these procedures, he/she will incur zero marks in that subject. Absentees will not be given a re-examination. Nonetheless, absent students should still apply for leave as stated (please refer to the Student Handbook) and submit the leave application documents to the class teacher on the next school day. The examination scores of absentees who follow the correct procedures will be calculated from their daily marks.
4. The S.6 Exam Script Review Days will be held from 6/2/2020 to 12/2/2020. Students should come to school and have lessons as usual according to the original timetable.
5. If the EDB announces a class suspension during the examination period, the examination(s) on that day will be rescheduled and it will be announced later. The remaining examinations will be held on the date and time of the original schedule.
