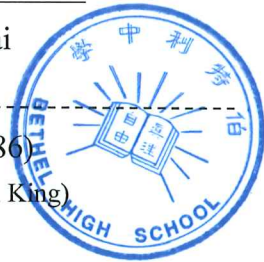

2022-2023 Sports Day Reminders

Dear Parents,

The school Sports Day will be held at Tin Shui Wai Sports Ground on 6th March, 2023 (Monday) and 7th March, 2023 (Tuesday). All students must participate and note the following:

1. Venue
Tin Shui Wai Sports Ground. (map attached below)



2. Time
8:15 a.m. - 1:30 p.m.
3. Stadium opening time
7:30 a.m.
4. Late
 - (1) Students who arrive after 8:15 will be marked as late and apply for leave.
 - (2) Discipline teachers / prefects will be on duty at the stadium gate to handle late students.
5. Sick leave
 - (1) Students who are absent because of illnesses should call the school General Office before 8:15 am that day and hand in a doctor certificate to the class teachers on the next school day. If not, they will be treated as a truant.
 - (2) Sick leave should be applied as usual. Students can refer to the Student Handbook or school rule.
6. Early leave
Early leave should be applied as usual. Students should apply to the House Tutors and gain their signature.
7. Uniform appearance
 - (1) Uniform criteria:
 - Students must wear full sport uniform. They should wear school sport T-shirt (according to the house of the student) on the upper body and school P.E. pants.
 - Winter or summer school uniform is not allowed in the competition area.
 - There is no exception for the House Committee members.
 - If it is too cold, students can wear sweaters and the school winter sport jacket, plain dark

blue open-chest / v-neck sweater or the school blazer.

- If student's uniform fails to fit the rules, the school may treat it as a violation of the school uniform rules. If you have any inquiries, please contact the discipline master (Tel: 24712622).
- During the competition, students can wear school blue sport trousers on the lower body. Students cannot wear or bring clothes not accepted by the school. Otherwise, students will not be allowed for competition or will be disqualified.
- Students can wear a Class shirt to cheer for their classmates during the inter-class relay.
- If a class plans to wear a Class shirt approved by the class teacher (Upper body only. However, the gear for lower body remains unchanged), the class should apply to the discipline master and provide information such as format / photo of the Class shirt so that teachers and prefects can still recognise the students.

(2) Uniform inspection:

Prefects and discipline teachers will guard the gate of the stadium and check the uniform of students. During the roll call, the class teachers will take the attendance and check students' uniform. During the announcement and the Opening Ceremony, the class teachers will keep the order of the students.

(3) Treatment to those who violate school uniform rules:

- Their name will be marked.
- If students wear incomplete sport uniform, their name will be marked.
- Students who wear non-designated clothes or seriously violate school uniform rules (e.g. dying hair or having more than 3 violation items) will be isolated and **disqualified for the competitions**.
- Offenders should carry the 'Uniform Rules Violation Certificate' given by the discipline teachers / prefects.

Rules in the stadium

- (1) Students cannot eat nor drink anything except water on the balcony.
- (2) Students should only take permitted things to the stadium.
- (3) Students should stay in the area of their own house to watch the events.
- (4) Students should not stay in the pathway of the balcony.
- (5) Students should keep order and follow the instructions from teachers.
- (6) Students should keep the place clean.
- (7) Students should not read any books on the balcony, except the Sports Day booklet.
- (8) If students violate rules, they will be punished accordingly or supervised in the isolated area.
- (9) Students should not use mobile phone without teacher's permission.

8. Regulation to toilet and tuck shop

- (1) Every house has 4 passes kept by the chief house tutors.
- (2) Every pass has a time limit of 10 minutes.
- (3) Pathways between the balconies will be used as queuing space.
- (4) Students should queue and hand in their student ID card or handbook (students must bring them) to the prefects. Prefects will record the time. If students forget to bring their student ID card / handbook, they need to be accompanied by House Tutors or prefects before they go to the toilet.
- (5) Students should have a valid pass to go to the toilet.
- (6) Offenders / late comers will be sent to the isolated area.

9. Students in the isolated area cannot join any competitions and will be supervised by teachers of the Order Team. If they violate rules in the isolated area, they will be punished to copy the school rules or compositions.
