




S1-5 Final Examination and Related Issues

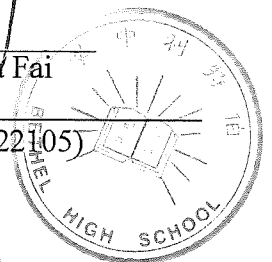
Dear S.1-S.5 Parents,

The final examinations are going to be held soon. Please urge your children to study in order to achieve good results. The details are as follows:

- (1) The final examinations (S1-S5) of this academic year will take place from 5<sup>th</sup> June to 16<sup>th</sup> June 2023. Please refer to the attachments regarding the examination timetables and revision guidelines for further details.
- (2) During the examination period, students still have to arrive at their designated classrooms for examinations no later than 8:10 am. They should arrive at the examination venue at least 15 minutes before the examination begins.
- (3) Application for leave of absence for personal reasons is prohibited, except in cases with very special reasons. For sick leave, students have to write down the reason in their student handbook and hand in a letter of absence signed by a registered doctor regardless of how many sick leave they take. Students who are absent from sick leave will not be given a make-up examination. The marks will be given according to the daily marks. (For details, please refer to the student handbook).
- (4) If the Education Bureau declares a suspension of classes, students will be notified of another arranged date for the examination and the examinations for other subjects will proceed according to the original timetable.
- (5) The Exam Script Review Days will be from 19<sup>th</sup> June 2023 to 21<sup>st</sup> June 2023. Students should have lessons according to the timetable after the class resumption. Please refer to the school website.
- (6) S.1 – S.3 Promotion criteria:
  - 6.1. The total average score of a student in a year should be 45 or above; and
  - 6.2. The attendance rate of a student in a year should not be less than 90%.
- (7) S.4 – S.5 Promotion criteria:
  - 7.1. The total average score of a student in a year should be 30 or above; and
  - 7.2. The attendance rate of a student in a year should not be less than 90%.
